In 2015, Riverwood served 38 different disabilities. Most common disabilities served were – Attention Deficit Disorder, Anxiety, Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Developmental Delays, Down syndrome, Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder, Seizure disorder, speech disorders, and visual impairment.

Celebrating a Milestone

Riverwood's 20th anniversary throughout 2015 was a milestone year for program participation, community outreach and fundraising. More than 600 were served through Riverwood's programs and we gained many new friends this year. We also lost three of our dearest equine partners; Sassy, Fits and Ibby. These horses/ponies were the last of our herd that started out in the "old barn". They helped hundreds of children develop a new sense of balance, gain inspiration for first words and they offered the best sensory experience available. Their spirits surround us here at the farm along with the others who have generously given their hearts, minds and bodies to our service.

It was also a pivotal year as we look toward the future. The board and staff have completed a three year strategic plan to guide us in the coming years. Demand for Riverwood's services continues to grow and a long term plan is vital for our ability to meet the need in our community. Our goals for the future include strategies for:

- Accommodating the increased demand for services with adequate staff, horses, volunteers and facilities.
- Creating a succession plan.
- Developing a strong and diverse board to support staff in awareness and fund development.
- Providing adequate training, housing and care for the Riverwood horses till the end of life.
- Maintaining high quality and professional staff as Riverwood grows through focus on education and professional development.

The future for Riverwood is bright and we have already made progress toward our goals. In the coming year you will see our instructors working toward PATH certification at the Advanced Level, additional classes to accommodate many of the students on our waiting list. You will also see our trails revitalized after years of wear and weather. In the next 3 years we will add some additional summer pasture space.

This year we have an exciting opportunity for a matching challenge grant that will allow us to realize many of the goals that we have set for the coming year. A generous and passionate individual who believes strongly in the healing power of equine assisted activities has challenged us to raise \$25,000 and she will match that dollar for dollar from now until August 15, 2016

Riverwood is dedicated to providing our services at an affordable rate as well as awarding sliding scale scholarships to families who need additional assistance. As we continue to serve more students and create new programs, our need for partnerships has never been greater. We are grateful for the thousands of members in our community who are already passionate about Riverwood's mission. Together we are making a significant impact in the lives of children and adults with special needs as well as the horses who are entrusted in our care.

Walk On, Katie Gibson

It's 1996 and Riverwood's first pilot program with the Children's Center is about to begin. A 3-year-old girl uses a walker to make her way to the arena so she can mount a horse for the first time. Challenges with muscle tone and balance don't allow her to sit without assistance, so a volunteer gently but firmly holds her in the saddle atop her horse's back. Further challenges with communication make it difficult for her to verbalize thoughts and feelings. This is how Riverwood first met Katie Gibson.



20 years later, Riverwood knows Katie as the beautiful, vibrant social butterfly who rides her horse, Sir, every Wednesday. From the moment she sets foot at Riverwood, the farm becomes a more joyous place to be. Without a walker, she always makes her first stop inside the office and classroom to greet the staff and her peers. Over the years Riverwood has given Katie an outlet to meet many new friends. The students, staff and volunteers have become much like family to Katie, and they have all helped her develop healthy relationships and improve her communication skills. We have also been witness to the physical benefits Katie has experienced from riding over the years; her balance has improved drastically, and her core and legs have become unbelievably strong. In addition to riding, Katie has enjoyed many hours of ground work with the horses and her long-time instructor, Laura Pallavicini. Ground therapy has provided Katie with emotional support, which has helped her overcome personal life challenges.

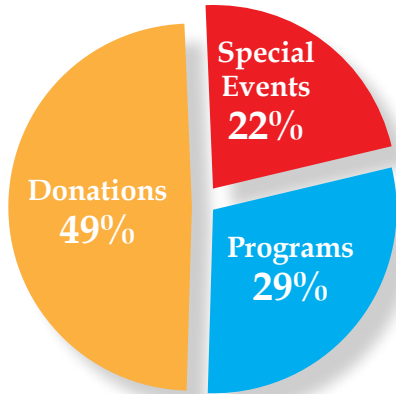
Katie's parents share "the love, respect, patience and encouragement (Riverwood staff and volunteers) have shown to Katie, along with a genuine compassion, has made a huge impact on who she is today." They claim Riverwood's program to be the most consistent and beneficial therapy Katie receives. "As a parent you always want to see your child succeed and accomplish new goals," Roy and Marie Gibson exclaim, "Katie has come so far and has advanced from having to be held on the horse to today where she sits very straight and is comfortable in the saddle. It makes us very proud to see how Katie has progressed in so many areas. We hope to continue to see Katie ride at Riverwood, and pray that one day she can ride unassisted." Financial Breakdown

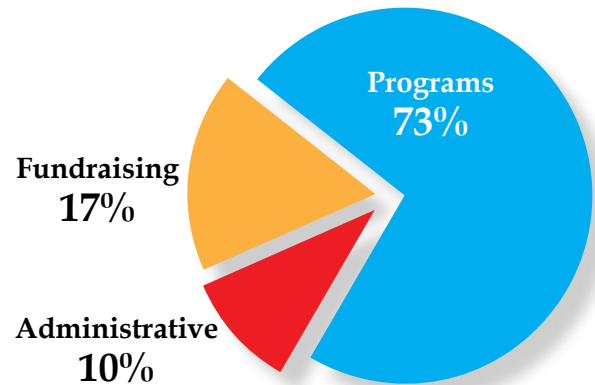

Riverwood is dedicated to improving the quality of life for individuals with special needs, regardless of his or her financial capability. **We subsidize the cost of riding lessons by 66% for all students;** beyond that, Riverwood provided \$5,429 in scholarships to those who could not afford tuition fees in 2015.
