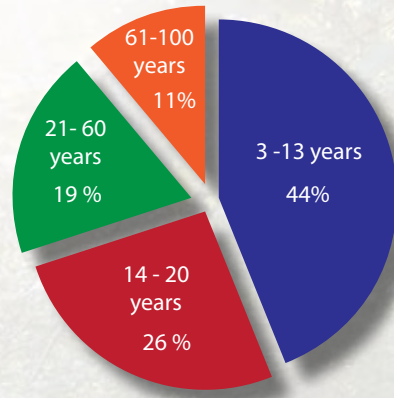

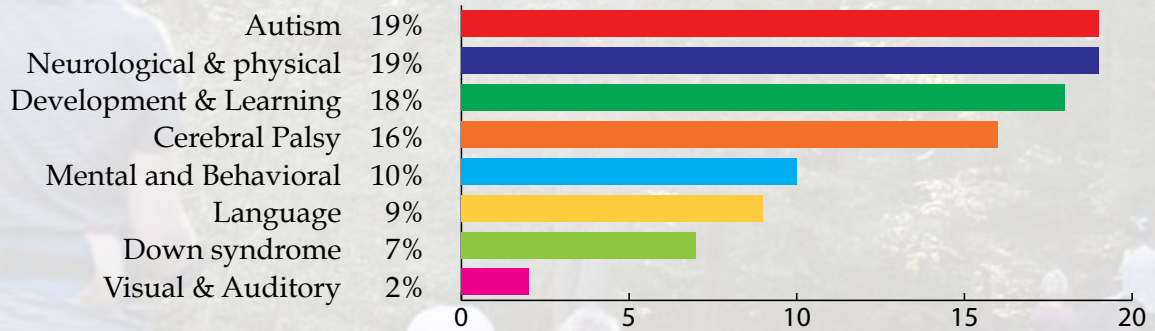
Riverwood provides quality, professional equine-assisted activities and farm-based and environmental learning opportunities for children and adults with special needs.

Dear Friends,

Thank you for helping Riverwood touch the lives of over 35,000 people in 2019. Our riding, outreach, educational and volunteer programs combined have provided an example to our community of just how life-changing the horse and the natural world can be to those who benefit from time spent with each. For almost 25 years, Riverwood has provided a welcoming place of inclusion and acceptance, regardless of age, race, ability, gender, religious belief or economic background. The farm and the horses provide an environment that focuses on generosity, kindness and capturing dreams.

As our community continues to demonstrate where it has needs that Riverwood can provide services, we continue to learn and educate others about the benefits of equine activities and immersion in a natural setting. The simple act of grooming a horse can lower cortisol levels and heart rate in the person who is holding the brush. The body and brain connection of opening a lead rope snap or buckling a halter strap can have long reaching outcomes for fine motor control. Holding reins and creating alignment of the torso, arms and fingers can assist in strengthening handwriting or typing skills.

The stress-reducing effects of nature have been documented in a large body of controlled experiments* and additional evidence demonstrates that providing the motion and rhythm of a horse builds strength, confidence and positive behaviors like empathy and communication.**

Being at the farm is good for the body and the soul for all people. Whether someone is benefitting from the movement of the horse to build up the strength of their muscles, or whether they are understanding more about themselves by strengthening their relationship with a horse, the horses are non-judgmental, honest and authentic every step of the way.

There is much that we see and feel at the farm that grounds us in awareness of the journey of each person who joins with the horses. Thank you for providing this work for our community and for supporting us as we grow into new and necessary areas of care.

Riverwood's program is made possible by the incredible members of our community who volunteer their time and talent with us each week. Our Herd

The average lifespan of a horse, according to the American Association of Equine Practitioners, is approximately 30 years. The combined age of the 18 Riverwood horses is over 330 years! Combining exceptional care, high quality feed, steady exercise, and an environment focused on well-being is the secret to having a herd who can provide hundreds of hours of interaction each month. As of 2019 the Riverwood herd has provided 4,722 total hours of lessons- both riding and ground- and have provided countless opportunities for students, volunteers and staff to learn, love and connect. None of this would be possible without the horses with whom we share our time. Our horses have a keen way of teaching us every day about things such as presence, honesty, partnership, and attentiveness. The wisdom they offer is full of metaphors for our own way of living and provide each of us lessons that reach far beyond riding.

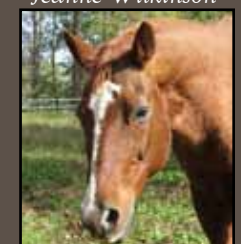

Community Connections

The community of Riverwood not only includes horse loving students and volunteers, but also many individuals who find that the farm offers a unique learning environment. By providing an inclusive and accessible environment, many talented individuals are intrigued when offered the opportunity to share their gifts with our students, families, and community at large. During the summer of 2019, it became clear that we could provide the learning and engagement space for an American Sign Language (ASL) class to be held for anyone who was interested in learning.

One of Riverwood's long-time riding students, Madeleine McGuire, is a very active member of the Deaf community in Forsyth County. Riverwood instructor, Evy Crumb, is fluent in ASL and often uses her skills with students, volunteers, and staff to help promote and teach valuable communication skills. As Madeleine has grown, she has become an active advocate for herself and the deaf community. Madeleine and her mother, Ceci, mentioned the possibility of using The Coop to host a series of ASL classes and the ball started rolling! Evy was excited to facilitate the planning, set up and welcoming of this special program to the Riverwood farm each week.

Lead by teacher extraordinaire Denise Oviatt, a certified interpreter and adjunct professor at Piedmont International University, the ASL course gained momentum and was attended by 15 students, staff, volunteers, parents, and interested individuals from the larger community. After 8 weeks of skill building, all the attendees were able to take their skills into the community and begin building bridges through communication and advocacy. Many volunteers and students have also utilized their skills to communicate with other Riverwood students in lessons.

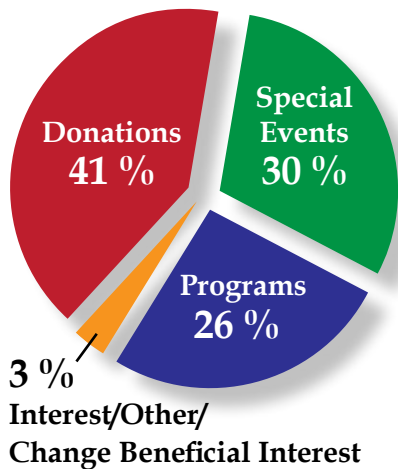

Financial Review

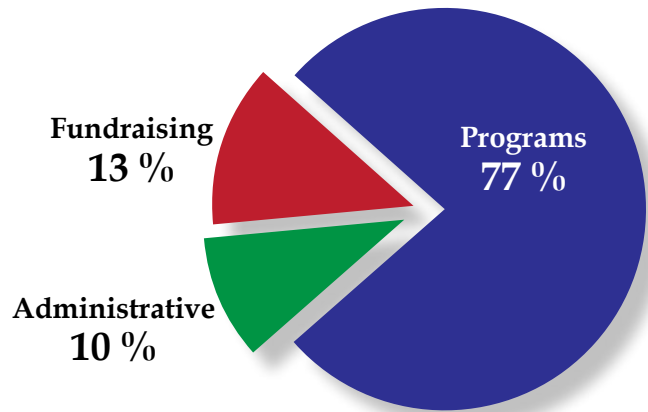
